- Stepfather, stepmother, stepson, stepdaughter, stepbrother or stepsister; or
- Unmarried partner with whom they have lived as a couple for at least two of the last three years.

In addition, children adopted under an adoption order recognised in UK law are treated as if they are the natural children of the adoptive parents.
